Dear Madam Clerk:

I am in receipt of your letter dated March 27, 2014. This case was tried during the term of court starting January 6, 2014. On January 8, 2014, the jury returned a verdict for the Plaintiff. A copy of the verdict is attached.

Thereafter, post-trial motions were filed and on February 18, 2014, a hearing was held before Judge Mullen on the post-trial motions. Following arguments on the post-trial motions, Judge Mullen ruled from the bench and denied the post-trial motions. On March 4, 2014, I filed the Notice of Appeal on behalf of the Defendant.

I received your letter requesting a copy of the written order. I have looked online at the Beaufort County Clerk's website, and at this time the judgment for the verdict in this matter does not appear to be filed. I also have had a staff member go to the Courthouse to obtain copies of the verdict and the order, if any, entered by the judge. At this time we cannot find where the verdict has been entered, although a copy is enclosed; nor is there any written order by Judge Mullen regarding the post-trial motions. In fact, I did not anticipate any written order from Judge Mullen since she ruled from the bench. Therefore, at this time, I have not been able to locate any written order from which to appeal. However, based upon my voice mail messages with you, I am putting in writing the attempts that we have made in order to obtain the judgment and written order in this matter.



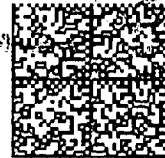
