Dear Mr. Shearouse,

I am in dire need of the Courts assistance. I just recently filed a second application for PCR due to the fact that my PCR counsel refused to file a Rule 59(E) Motion on my behalf as requested and as a result, all of the issues that I raised at the original hearing were not fully adjudicated on. I am asking the Court to allow me the opportunity to have this matter addressed and put my currently appeal on hold so that I may have all of my issues reviewed by this Court. I believe that a Austin v. State, petition is the appropriate remedy to preserve the issues I'd like to have reviewed during this appeal. Because a failure to file a Rule 59(E) Motion impacts on the appellate rights of the appellant. Inasmuch as it deprives me of the opportunity to seek appellate review of unpreserved issues, Austin v. State, 409 S.E. 2d 395, 396 (S.C. 1991) ("The Court will allow a successive application" where applicant was denied right to appeal denial of PCR issues.") It is impossible to be in two Courts at the same time for the same exact situation, so I would ask the Court for a "Stay and Abeyance" so that all of my issues are heard and I receive a full bite of the apple. Along with this letter/request to this Court, is also a letter/request to my current court appointed attorney who'll be briefing my issues to this Court in a petition for Certiorari, Ms. Kathrine Hudgins asking her to render me the same assistance I seek from this Honorable Court. Any assistance you can give me in this regards will be greatly appreciated.
