Dear Ms. Kitchings:

This letter is to request a fifteen day extension of time to request the hearing transcripts with regard to the appeal of the above referenced matter.

By way of explanation, the Notice of Appeal was filed on May 16, 2014. As a result, the Appellants are required to order transcripts within ten days per Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR. The Appellants have previously ordered and received the trial transcript for this appeal as well as the transcript for the hearing on post-trial motions which was held on March 28, 2014. By my count, however, there were at least 26 other hearings held during the course of this litigation from 2005 through 2014. I am requesting additional time in order to complete my review of the hearings that were held so that I can make a final determination of what transcripts are still needed to order for purposes of this appeal. I will also need to coordinate with the Respondents' counsel to make sure there are not any additional transcripts that they believe are required for this appeal.

I was unable to complete this task in the past ten days because I was in trial in the Georgetown County Court of Common Pleas from May 19th through the 22nd. I also had two appellate briefs due in the past ten days as well. For this reason, and given the complexity and magnitude of this litigation and the appeal, I must request additional time for ordering the needed transcripts for the appeal.

I have not enclosed the filing fee because as a state agency the Appellant SCDC is exempt. If you require a formal motion, please advise.
