

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on April 14, 2014 the Grand Jurors of
Orangenburg County present upon their oath:

BURGLARY - FIRST DEGREE

That in Orangeburg County, South Carolina, on or between December 10 and
December 15, 2013, the Defendant, Joshua Namon Beck, did willfully and
unlawfully enter the dwelling of Cornelius Furtick, without consent and with the
intent to commit a crime therein and when, in effecting entry or while in the
dwelling or in immediate flight, he or another participant in the crime was armed
with a deadly weapon or explosive. This offense being a violation of Section 16-
11-311 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended.
