Kenneth William Green, the *pro se* Appellant in the afore-captioned appeal from the Administrative Law Court, respectfully moves this Honorable Court, pursuant to Rule 240(a), South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, for an Extension of Time in which to file his Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to Be Included in the Record.

The *pro se* Appellant moved this Honorable Court for permission to proceed *in forma pauperis* on April 9, 2014. This Court, in an Order by Justice H. Bruce Williams, dated May 19, 2014, granted Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

Appellant submits that he is unable to comply with the ten day deadline in which to file his initial brief. The *pro se* Appellant is in a unique circumstance of incarceration where he is required to adhere to movement and accessibility schedules and has a very limited time in which to access the institutional law library and conduct the necessary research of issues and the procedural requirements for an appellate brief. Appellant must also compile and collate materials necessary for the designation of matter to be included in the record.


Based on the foregoing facts, Appellant moves this Honorable Court for an Extension of Time of thirty (30) days, up to and including June 18, 2014 in which to file his Initial Brief. Appellant submits that this motion is made in good faith, not with the intent to intentionally delay, that Appellant has sought no other extensions of time, and that the Respondents will not be prejudiced by this extension.

#### CONCLUSION

**WHEREFORE**, based on the foregoing, the Appellant prays this Honorable Court grant this Motion for Extension of Time of thirty (30) days, up to and including June 18, 2014 to file his Initial Brief in the afore-captioned appeal.



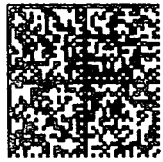
