Dear Mrs. Allen:

On March 23-24, 2014, I wrote three (3) court reporters. I have only heard from one (1) court reporter, Mrs. Margaret Sullivan. As you know, I promptly mailed her a U.S. Postal Money Order. I understand Mrs. Sullivan has 60 days to transcribe and deliver the transcript. Although, I have not received a receipt, I am patiently awaiting the prescribed time frame.

Neither Melissa Singletary nor Hilda Jordan acknowledged my written request for a transcript.

What happened? Are they still employed with SC Court Administration? Would you provide an update? Absent *any* response, oral or writing, I am gravely concerned.

The online Court Reporter manual (*dated August 16, 2011*) states "*all transcript requests must be submitted in writing or via e-mail to the court reporter...*"

Also, in my March 24, 2014 letter to you, I indicated that Judge Clifton Newman presided over the Common hearing on June 17, 2013 in Sumter County. Again, would you provide me with the name of the fourth Court Reporter so I may initiate a written request?
