Dear Mr. Ingram:

I am writing to follow up on the March 31, 2014, deficiency letter from our Clerk's office.

In that letter the court identified instances in which the document you filed did not comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. We have already given you ten days to make the corrections. If you fail to correct these deficiencies within **ten** days of the date of this letter, your document may not be considered by the court. The deficiencies we previously identified were:

- A proof of service has not been provided stating the motion to proceed in forma pauperis was served. The proof of service filed indicates the notice of appeal was served. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
