MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Nathaniel McGee respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 2, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third and final request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Mr. McGee respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. William Coaxum with this Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Edward Dunn with the Court of Appeals on May 7, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Steven Frost with the Court of Appeals on May 7, 2014. Counsel filed reply to the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Marion Bowman v. State with this Court on May 5, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Zinah Damaris Jennings (transcripts and pleadings exceeded 1,800 pages) in the Court of Appeals on May 1, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Erick Arroyo with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2014. Counsel filed Reply Brief of Petitioner in the case of State v. Jomar Robinson with this Court on April 11, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. James Allen Johnson with the Court of Appeals on April 9, 2014. Counsel had oral argument in the case of State v. Steven Kranendonk with the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of


certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of In The Interest of Tyairy G., Minor with this Court on April 1, 2014.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




