Dear Judge Manning:

Since writing you on November 22<sup>nd</sup>, I have been copied on responses from Mr. Gende and Mr. Jones.

Mr. Gende continues to seek an informal but indefinite stay based on his inability to identify his clients and/or their interest in this action. I must note for the Court that this case was brought nearly a year after the *Wilson v. Dallas* appeal was filed. The Wingate firm and its clients were on notice that Mr. Buchanan and Mrs. Pope sought to void the settlement, and the Supreme Court eventually did just that.

For nearly 4 years, my client has been subject to scurrilous allegations which have served their intended purpose of damaging her career and reputation. Further, her counterclaims against all Plaintiffs await further discovery and trial, and she should be allowed to immediately proceed with them. If the Wingate firm is unable to identify its clients, it should take appropriate measures to rectify that situation. I ask that the Court not indulge Mr. Gende's unreasonable request to instead further punish my client for the Wingate firm's poor planning.

I have requested that the Court proceed with hearing the Attorney General's "Motion to be Dropped as a Party" and our Motion to Add William Forlando J. Brown as a Party. Mr. Jones has stated that the AG does not object to proceeding with those. I respectfully ask again that the Court schedule a hearing at its earliest convenience.
