
I am writing to follow up on the May 2, 2014, and May 16, 2014, deficiency letters from our Clerk's office.

In that letter the court identified instances in which the documents you filed did not comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. We have determined that those deficiencies are serious enough that we must dismiss the appeal if they are not corrected. We have already given you ten days to make the corrections. If you fail to correct these deficiencies within **ten** days of the date of this letter, your appeal will be dismissed. The deficiencies we previously identified were:

- The proof of service for your record on appeal has not been signed.
- The record on appeal is not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel.
- Your final reply brief is not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel.

- All counsel of record, addresses, and phone numbers must be listed on the cover of the record on appeal, pursuant to Rule 267, SCACR.
