MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of five (5) days until June 13, 2014** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today, June 9, 2014.
2. **Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Counsel intended to file the petition today. However, counsel's assistant is unavailable today due to a family health issue, and counsel does not believe he can file a completed petition in strict compliance with the Court's rules**

without her help today. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On May 22, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Tony Moore v. State with this Court. On May 20, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in State v. Antonio Scott with this Court. On April 24, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Roy Johnson, Jr. v. State with this Court. On April 18, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Maurice Shaundell Hope v. State with this Court. On April 17, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Taveio Boston v. State with this Court. On April 16, 2014, counsel filed a petition for rehearing in State v. Ricky S. Bowman with the Court of Appeals. On April 4, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Conrad Little v. State with this Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.
