

ORDER

By order dated July 13, 2012, the Honorable Edgar W. Dickson was assigned to the post-conviction relief (PCR) action filed by appellant. Judge Dickson, by order dated June 2, 2014, has recused himself from further participation in the case. The Honorable G. Thomas Cooper is hereby assigned to appellant's PCR action.

Within thirty days of the date of this order, Judge Cooper shall issue a scheduling order setting forth the schedule to be followed in the matter, including the date of the hearing on the merits. The scheduling order may be amended as necessary. A copy of the scheduling order and any amended scheduling order shall be provided to counsel, this Court and Court Administration. In addition to appellant's obligation to notify the Clerk of this Court of the status of this matter every sixty days under *In re Stays of Execution in Capital Cases*, 321 S.C. 544, 471 S.E.2d 140 (1996), Judge Cooper is requested to provide the Clerk of this Court and Court Administration with an update on the status of the matter every one hundred and twenty days.
