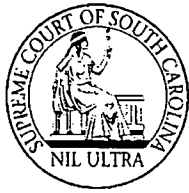

Dear Mr. Brittain:

The Office of Bar Admissions has received your Verified Applications for Admission Pro Hac Vice on behalf of Jeffrey S. Cashdan and Zachary A. Rule 404(c), SCACR.
