MOTION TO REINSTATE APPEAL

The Appellant respectfully requests that her appeal is reinstated for the following:

1. The Appellant was under the impression from the Court that her appeal was held in abeyance after receiving correspondence from the Court on April 16, 2014.
2. The Appellant submitted a Motion for an Extension within the (10) days ordered by the Court to file an initial brief. The Appellant's filing fee was returned with a letter stating that the case was being held in abeyance. The Appellant did not intentionally ignore the


directive from the Court because a Motion for an Extension was filed. An initial brief could have not been submitted without the transcript from the hearing that was held in Orangeburg, South Carolina in which the Appellant did not attend because she was in the hospital. The Appellant submitted verification of her hospitalization to the court, but the hearing went forward.

3. The Court stated that they have evidence that the Respondent mailed the Appellant a copy of the transcript. The Appellant never received a copy of any transcript. The Appellant is respectfully requesting the proof that the Court has on file verifying that she received a copy of the transcript.
4. If the Court has a copy of the transcript, the Appellant is requesting a copy. The Appellant will pay for the copies.
5. The Respondents committed mortgage fraud. The dismissal of this appeal will cause the Appellant irreparable damage.
6. The Appellant is also communicating with several federal agencies in reporting the Respondents for mortgage fraud.
7. Again, the Appellant is requesting a copy of the transcript from the Court if one is on file. Also, the verification from the court that the Appellant received a copy of the transcript from the Respondent.
8. The Appellant has attempted securing a transcript from court reporters, but was unsuccessful. The Appellant is submitting correspondences from the court reporters. The Appellant even attempted to secure this transcript by communicating with the Court Administration's Office.

For the above reasons, the Appellant respectfully requests that her appeal is reinstated and copy of the transcript is mailed to her by the court to make certain that the Appellant receives it. The Appellant will pay for all copying and mailing expenses.

I am in receipt of your letter of August 26, 2013 requesting transcript costs. Please forward to me the date, county, judge, complete caption of the case for each hearing so that I may locate your proceeding in my records. I am unable to estimate cost with just the civil action number.

Generally, cost is figured at \$3.25 per page. Court reporters have 60 days to complete a transcript. If there is good cause sent in writing to Court Administration we may be granted up to three extensions of 30 days each.

Thank you for your letter.

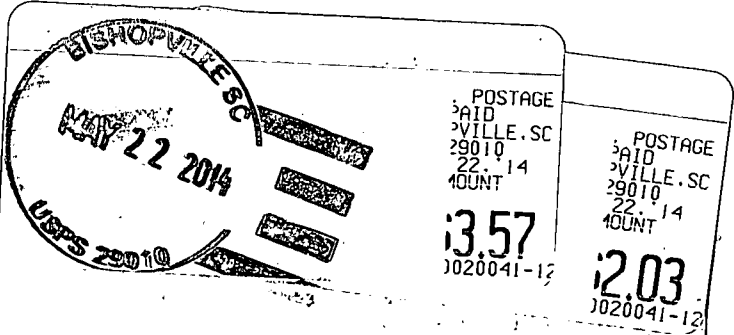
