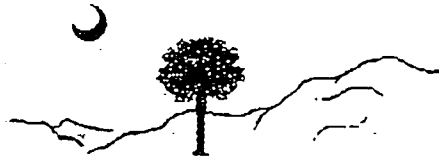
Dear Counsel:
