

me or if she threatened me and then opened the door. I stepped back into the cell at this time. I told her look "I just wanted to be presentable, I have a high profile case." She basically told me "let go, get your jumpsuit on" I think that was the part where she said "Are you refusing a direct order?" And I said "No, I'm not refusing a direct order, look just let me brush my teeth." She threatened me three or four times to taze me throughout this encounter. After I told her to just let me brush my teeth, she tazed me. ~~Then~~ I never threatened her, my body language wasn't threatening. I even went as far as when she stepped in the room to back up and give her space. Then nurse Lancaster came and took the projectiles out of my left bicep and left hip. I was bleeding where the projectiles came out. Shortly after that Captain Ham and Lt. Hankins came and I told them she shot me for no reason. Then I got my jumpsuit on and Lt. Hankins had Sgt. Kerr take me to the courthouse and I sat there for about one hour. Then I was never seen and Sgt. Kerr took me back to the detention center. It was about 11:49 am or 11:52 am. I told ~~Kerr~~ ^{me} Sgt. Kerr that I needed something to put on my wounds. Nurse Wally came to my cell and bandaged them. Then they put me on lockdown until further notice. Then a day or two later, nurse Lancaster, officer Reeves and officer Rodriguez came to my cell. We got in a short conversation and officer Reeves told me that I wasn't even the one that was - see page 3
