
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANT’S REPLY BRIEF

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263(b), SCACR, Appellant Jabari Linnen, by and through the undersigned counsel, respectfully requests a 10-day extension of time in which to file his Reply Brief. On May 28, 2014, counsel for Appellant requested a 30-day extension of time to file the Reply Brief due to scheduling difficulties arising after the filing of Respondent’s Initial Brief that left counsel without adequate time to prepare the Reply Brief prior to the expiration of the abbreviated ten-day deadline set forth in Rule 208(a)(3). On May 29, 2014, the Court granted Appellant a 10-day extension of time to file the Reply Brief. Due to continued scheduling difficulties, counsel for Appellant requests an additional 10-day extension of time to file the Reply Brief.

The current deadline for filing the Reply Brief is Monday, June 9, 2014 and has been extended once previously as described above. Appellant respectfully requests an additional 10-day extension of time so that the new deadline will be Thursday, June 19, 2014. Counsel for Appellant will file the Reply Brief in advance of the deadline to the extent possible and does not anticipate the need for further extension requests.


