Dear Counsel:

We have received your motion to admit Deborah G. Casey pro hac vice in the above matter on appeal. Please be advised, effective May 14, 2014, the Supreme Court of South Carolina amended Rule 404, SCACR, to, among others, provide that "[i]f the motion to appear pro hac vice is granted [in the lower court], the authority to appear pro hac vice shall continue through the remainder of the action or proceeding, including any appellate proceedings, unless permission is withdrawn as provided in (h), below." Rule 404(c), SCACR.
