
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

The appeal of the above-referenced matter is being held in abeyance pursuant to the Court's letter dated April 16, 2012 pending the final resolution of the appeal in the CarMax Auto Super Stores West Coast, Inc. v. South Carolina Department of Revenue (Appeal from the Administrative Law Court Case No. 09-ALJ-17-0160-CC) (the "CarMax Appeal"). In compliance with the Court's instructions requesting status updates every 60 days, we summarize below the status of the CarMax Appeal.

After the Court of Appeal's April 16th letter, the parties in the CarMax appeal both filed Motions for Rehearing. The Court of Appeals denied these motions on May 7, 2012. On June 6, 2012, both parties filed Petitions for Writ of Certiorari to the South Carolina Supreme Court. Those petitions are pending with responses due by both parties on July 6, 2012.
