
General Sessions Court.



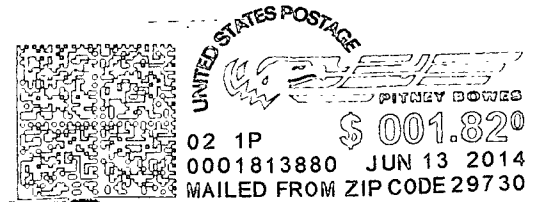
