MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Matthew Antwain Jackson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until July 9, 2014**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Matthew Antwain Jackson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Henry Gray with this Court on May 13, 2014. Counsel filed Petition for Rehearing in the case of State v. Julian Deandre Battle in this Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. William Coaxum with the Supreme Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Edward Dunn with this Court on May 7, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Steven Frost with this Court on May 7, 2014. Counsel filed reply to the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Marion Bowman v. State with the Supreme Court on May 5, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Zinah Damaris Jennings (transcripts and pleadings exceeded 1,800 pages) in this Court on May 1, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Erick Arroyo with this Court on April 16, 2014. Counsel filed Reply Brief of Petitioner in the case of State v. Jomar Robinson with the Supreme Court on April 11, 2014.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




