To whom it may concern,
On May 28, 2014 I received an Order dated May 6,
2014 forwarded to my attorney from this court
dismissing my appeal. Accordingly my attorney failed
to comply with Rule 243(c) of SCACR. On-
doing so he has failed to provide an explanation as to
why the lower court determination was improper.
An explanation that contains sufficient facts, arguments,
and citation to legal authority showing
arguable basis.

As a result of my attorney lack of performance my appeal has been dismissed. This dismissal due to his procedural error has prejudiced me by denying me complete access to the appellate process. Under the PCR rule, an applicant is entitled to a full adjudication on the merits of the original petition, or "one bite at the apple"; this bite includes an applicant's right to appeal the denial of a post-conviction relief application, and the right to assistance of counsel in that appeal (Rules Civ Proc. Rule 71. P(g) *Idom*, 337 S.C. at 261, 523 SE 2d 755 Citing *Lice v. State*, 305 S.C. 448, 452, 409 SE 2d 392, 395 (1991); *Austin v. State* 305 S.C. 453, 409 SE 2d 395 (1991))

↳ On *Austin*, the defendant never received a full "bite at the apple" because he was prevented from seeking any review of the denial of his PCR application.

According to the letter my attorney forwarded to me enclosed with the order this ends my appeal.

Backed by S.C. Supreme Court previous rulings I wholeheartedly disagree. How shall I go about obtaining my one full "bite at the apple" that comes with complete access to the appellate process?

Enclosed is the Order I received from the Supreme Court of South Carolina stating they will not hear your appeal and the matter is dismissed. I called them to confirm that they received the notice of appeal and the statement of grounds for appeal from the PCR hearing, and they have received both. They are saying that, even assuming our claims are true, they will not grant the appeal.

There is nowhere else to appeal this ruling. You may appeal to the United States Supreme Court or file a petition for habeas in the federal court, but I do not think either would be successful.



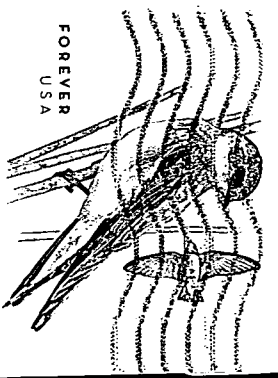

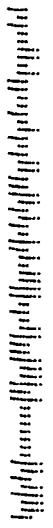
