ORDER

After careful consideration, this appeal is dismissed because Appellant failed to timely serve the Workers' Compensation Commission with the notice of appeal. See Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR ("[T]he notice of appeal shall be served on the agency . . . within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision [on appeal]."); Rule 263(b), SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act *except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rules 203 and 243* may be extended or shortened by the appellate court" (emphasis added)). Because this appeal is dismissed, this Court need not act on Appellant's pending motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
