Dear Clerk of Court:

I, Vincent Missouri, IIM # 197996, that is currently being held at Kirkland Reception and Evaluation Center, located at 4344 Broadriver Rd, in Columbia, S.C., where I've resided since my questionable conviction. Do forward my following concerns.

I for one, do not and cannot muster any trust in the county of Pickens, to which I was convicted, or the attorney which was "forced upon me", to have filed my absolutely requested "Intent to Appeal". When inmates arrive at R+E, they are given two envelopes. On Wednesday the 21st of May 2014 I arrived. By Tuesday May 27, 2014 or before, my "personal Intent to appeal" was personally sent from Kirkland to Pickens County, S.C. at 214 E. MAIN Street, Pickens, S.C. 29671. However, no receipt has been mailed to this appellant.

In addition, there was and is a pending "habeas corpus" 2013-CP-230-6448 attacking the circuit court's jurisdiction to have tried the above cases when the jury was empaneled, to which the defense attorney and solicitor was aware on 5-19-2014

for which the circuit court failed to put to rest prior to trying the criminal case which should raise some concern of whether this conviction "on its face" could possibly stand, whereas if the habeas corpus succeeded, the indictment would have to be dismissed. [habeas corpus was filed 10-22-2013]

Mr. Aaron Angell's incompetence since he was assigned to my case has been repeatedly met by my opposition. His Clemson address is 398 College Ave., Clemson, S.C. 29631. My issues on appeal consist of, but not limited to the below listed items:

- (1) Whether Missouri was denied his Sixth Amendment right to "Choice of Counsel"?
- (2) Whether Missouri was denied his Sixth Amendment "right to represent himself"?
- (3) Whether Missouri was denied his fourteenth Amendment right to a impartial judge and a fair trial?
- (4) Whether Missouri was denied his fourteenth and fifth Amendment rights to Due Process, a Fast + Speedy Trial and the administrative procedures for obtaining a True Billed Indictment?
- (5) Whether Missouri was exposed to illegal search and seizure, in violation of his fourth Amendment rights, constituting cruel and unusual punishment, under the Eighth Amendment?
- (6) Whether Missouri recieved ineffective assistance of counsel, by such attorney which was forced upon him against his will?
- (7) Whether the circuit court retained jurisdiction to hold trial in light of a pending challenge to its jurisdiction. Where such attack was filed since 10-22-2013?

In Pickens County, I was openly discriminated against, and treated highly prejudicial. Therefore, I don't even trust that the transcripts will accurately reflect the events that took place. Because if the transcripts are an accurate reflection of events, this court will have no problem vacating the conviction.

I was even tried without "a true billed indictment." When alerting the court at sentencing, because I refused to sign the sentencing sheet to charges I never seen an indictment for. He responded, "such did not matter" because the jury has already convicted me.

Really, I need a investigator to watchover my appeal and transcript, because normally, when a direct appeal is filed by a attorney, they forward the defendant such copy for proof and his records. I have not received such proof and is directly why I am contacting this Honorable Court. Please respond informing me of the status of such filings.

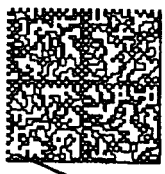

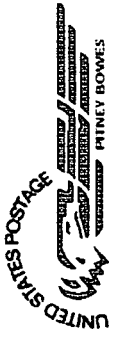

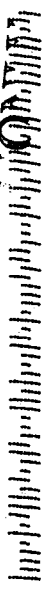
