ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to compel Appellant to supplement the record on appeal with three matters previously designated by Respondent. The matters include: (1) Appellant's sentencing sheet from his current conviction for Trafficking Crack Cocaine (3rd offense); (2) Appellant's notice of appeal in the Administrative Law Court for KRCI 0078-13; and (3) the December 10, 2013 order by Administrative Law Judge John D. McLeod. Appellant filed a response, indicating he does not have copies of the designated material. Within ten days, Respondent shall furnish Appellant with a copy of these three matters. Appellant has twenty days thereafter to serve and file a supplemental record on appeal that contains these omitted matters. Respondent's request for an extension to serve and file Respondent's final brief is granted. Respondent shall serve and file Respondent's final brief within thirty days of receiving service of the supplemental record on appeal.
