
Dear Ms. Hawkins:

- You must serve and file a notice of appeal, excluding your arguments and substantially in the format provided in Appendix C of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Failure to cure the above deficiencies within ten(10) days can result in the dismissal of this appeal.
