ORDER

Petitioner moves to file a second supplemental appendix in response to this Court's request that he provide a paper copy of the contents of a compact disc entered as petitioner's Exhibit 8 at the post-conviction relief hearing and in the possession of this Court pursuant to a transportation order. The State does not oppose the motion, but makes an additional suggestion to assist the Court in accessing the contents of the CD in the process of reviewing this matter.

We grant petitioner's motion to file a second supplemental appendix and accept the supplemental appendix as filed. We also follow the State's suggestion and hereby direct the parties to make specific reference in their filings to any relevant portion of the CD, including by file folder, and when applicable, page number. Petitioner shall have twenty days from the date of this order to serve and file a supplement to his petition for a writ of certiorari setting forth such references and indicating the specific portion of the petition to which they are relevant.
