

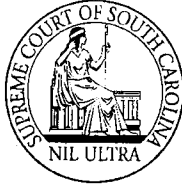

This responds to your letter to Chief Justice Toal dated May 31, 2014. Please be advised that the Chief Justice cannot consider your *ex parte* communication about the above matter.

I note that the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter by order dated April 28, 2014. Further, when no petition for reinstatement or rehearing was received within time specified by Rules 221 or 260 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur. Rule 221, SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, and no further motions can be considered in this matter. *Wise v. South Carolina Dept. of Corrections*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).

Finally, as to the \$150 money order, the Court of Appeals' letter of April 2, 2014, indicates that this money
