ORDER

This case was remitted to the Administrative Law Court on March 21, 2014. Subsequently, Appellant filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking payment for attorney's fees and expenses in the amount of \$1,187.99. Specifically, Appellant seeks reimbursement for \$1,000 in attorney's fees and \$187.99 in copying fees. However, we decline to award Appellant attorney's fees and expenses. *See* Rule 222(a), SCACR (explaining that when an appeal is affirmed or reversed in part or is vacated, costs shall be allowed only as ordered by the appellate court).
