To Whom It May Concern;

I am writing this letter in reference to Mr. Allen Stone, inmate number: 205497. I reviewed Mr. Stone's letter concerning the use of a diuretic inadvertently instead of the ibuprofen that had actually been ordered for him previously. In review of all the information that is currently available to me, I find that the only symptom that he describes that is likely attributable to the use of this medicine is the increased frequency of urination that he had initially. His current laboratory data shows that he has normal kidney function and there is no evidence of abnormal findings on his urine analysis. We are currently in the process of understanding how this error was made and to implement corrective measures.

In summary, although there was an error in medication administration, there is no objective evidence of any harm. We will, of course, continue to monitor his condition carefully and to be sure to implement the corrective actions we find appropriate after we have finished our review.

Please feel free to contact me should you have any further questions concerning this. We will continue to keep you updated on any events related to this event.
