I owe medical and since I can not afford my own copies they would only make me (3) ~~of~~ of each.

And the next issue is that they want make copies of hand-written material unless the pages were clock-dated and stamped.

Wherefore, if you have a solution upon this situation please respond to let me know what I need to try and do. And may I please be forwarded a clock-dated stamp copy of my Final Reply Brief.
