Re: Notice of Prejudice, Possible Actual Injury or Irreparable Harm regarding the MCI Law Library System

Dear Justice Toal:

I am respectfully submitting this letter to you in regards to the case of Alvin S. Samuels, II v The State of South Carolina 2013-CR40-1556, in which I am currently appealing the "Order of Dismissal" of presiding Judge James Barber. I proceeded "Pro Se" in my Evidentiary Hearing of January 22, 2014. I also wish to proceed "Pro Se" for my Appeal. In doing so I will suffer great prejudice, actual injury and possible irreparable harm, because of the McCormick Correctional Institutional Law Library System inadequacy, deficiency and short-comings in allowing me reasonable adequate reliable access to the courts.

I am currently housed at the McCormick Correctional Institution and use and need resources and access to their law library. Despite multiple request to these prison officials, they still fail to allow me to use the law library, and make the library meet standards, as guaranteed by SCDC Policy GA-01.03, Bounds v. Smith and other Federal law. Their system for allowing inmates with court deadlines or pending cases use the law library is not reliable and insufficient for meeting deadlines, moreso "Pro Se" Litigants.

Wherefore, I submit this letter to you verifying that their system is inadequate and fails to allow inmates to meet deadlines. Being I am currently in your courts I am advising this court that with their system I will miss deadlines and chance actual injury or possible irreparable

harm. I am currently exhausting my administrative remedies so I can get a preliminary injunction by the District Courts of the 4th Circuit so that the MCI system comply with SCDC Policy and Federal Law.

I respectfully ask this court to give great consideration of the prejudice I am and will suffer, being I am acting diligently to correct this institution system and short comings while currently Appealing my "Order of Dismissal" my main priority
