MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Talmadge Rowell respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until July 28, 2014**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Talmadge Rowell respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Jose Angel Herrera v. State with the Supreme Court on May 15, 2014. Counsel filed an initial reply brief of appellant in the case of State v. Akeem O. Smith with this Court on May 15, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Henry Gray with this Court on May 13, 2014. Counsel filed Petition for Rehearing in the case of State v. Julian Deandre Battle in this Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. William Coaxum with the Supreme Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Edward Dunn with this Court on May 7, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Steven Frost with this Court on May 7, 2014. Counsel filed reply to the return to the petition for writ of


certiorari in the case of Marion Bowman v. State with the Supreme Court on May 5, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Erick Arroyo with this Court on April 16, 2014.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


