PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT/RECONSIDERATION

I hereby petition this Court for Reinstatement/Reconsideration, & states:

1. The Honorable Jasper M. Cureton, AJ, dismissed this appeal because the memorandum of the ALJ clerk's office is not a Final order. This is error where the proper order would be an order remanding to the ALJ with instructions for the ALJ to issue a Final order.
2. A Final order is an order that "dispose[s] of the cause... reserving no further questions or directions for future determination." Keiti Ripley, LLC v. Emerald Investments, LLC, 404 S.C. 367, 746 S.E.2d 26 (S.C. 2013). See Howard v. SLOC, 399 S.C. 618, 733 S.E.2d 211 (S.C. 2012), the ALJ could have ruled on the constitutionality of the claim.
3. WHEREFORE, I pray this Court Reconsider its' previous denial &/or Reinstate this appeal & Remand to the ALJ with instructions.
