

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION AND TO REMOVE PAGES FROM
RECORD ON APPEAL FILED WITH COURT**

The undersigned, as counsel for the Appellant hereby moves for a twenty (20) day extension of time to file his Final Briefs. This Motion is made on the grounds that additional time is needed to prepare the Final Briefs in light of the fact that incorrect deposition pages were inadvertently included in the Record on Appeal. The parties are in the process of straightening out the Record on Appeal but need additional time to do so. This extension request is not intended for purposes of delay. Further, there would be no prejudice to the parties by an extension of time. By the undersigned's calculations the extension, if granted, would extend Appellant's deadline for filing the record on appeal to July 2, 2014.

In addition, the Appellant moves for leave of the Court to remove the following pages from the Record on Appeal. These pages contain material inadvertently put into the Record on Appeal but which were not part of the Lower Court record: Page 457, Pages 463-467; Page 470; Page 472-475; Page 506; Page 520; Pages 526-528; Page 584-588; Pages 590-591. This Motion is made on the grounds that leave of the Court to physically remove these pages from the existing filed Record on Appeal will prevent Appellant from having to incur the cost of redoing the Record on Appeal which consists of three (3) volumes and some 1280 pages.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully prays that this Court extend the deadline for the service and filing the Final Briefs to July 2, 2014 and to grant Appellant's counsel leave of Court to remove the above-referenced pages from the filed Record on Appeal.
