Dear Solicitor Rogers and Mr. Tatarsky:

Please be advised that the Remittitur was issued on June 16, 2014 concerning the appeal in State v. Lorenzo Jermaine Inman. In that appeal, the South Carolina Court of Appeals vacated the kidnapping sentence – not the conviction – on Indictment 2009-GS-17-1205 involving the kidnapping of Mary Stutts. State v. Inman, Appellate Case No. 2010-179106, Unpub. Op. No. 2014-UP-197 (S.C.Ct.App. 2014). This decision has no effect on any of Mr. Inman's convictions or sentences he has on any other indictments which remain intact.

Please correct your records to reflect the vacation of the kidnapping sentence on this indictment pursuant to the Court's decision and S.C. Code §16-3-910. I am enclosing a copy of the Opinion and Remittitur Letter.


