MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Curtis R. Sweatt respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until August 7, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:



4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


