MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Charles Monroe Harris respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until August 8, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Charles Monroe Harris respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel is also working on and planning to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Harold Cartwright with the Court of Appeals on July 11, 2014. Counsel filed a motion to vacate convictions, remand for a new trial and to dismiss the appeal in the case of State v. Christina Reece with the Court of Appeals on July 3, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Richard Niles Jr. in this Court on Wednesday, June 25, 2014. Counsel is working on and preparing to file the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Christopher Heller in this Court on today, June 23, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Joseph Walker with the Court of Appeals on Friday, June 13, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Darian Robinson in this Court yesterday, June 12, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Bayan Aleskey, a death penalty case with this Court on June 6, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Anthony C. Johnson with the Court of Appeals on June 4, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. McIver Feagin with the Court of Appeals on May 23, 2014. Counsel went to death row at Lieber Correctional Institution on May 22, 2014 to meet with Sammie Stokes to discuss and prepare for the upcoming reconstruction hearing. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Mark Peters with the Court of Appeals on Thursday, May 22, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of Michael Hough v. State with the Court of Appeals on May 21, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Derrick McDonald with this Court on May 13, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Interest of Samuel B., a Juvenile Under the Age of Seventeen with the Court of Appeals on May 7, 2014.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




