MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Randall Sanders respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Randall Sanders respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Forrest Kelly Samples with the Court of Appeals on June 17, 2104. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Donald M. Anderson in the Court of Appeals on June 17, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of George Wigington v. State of South Carolina with the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gregory Mark Crolley v. State of South Carolina with this Court on June 5, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Gregory Ivery in the Court of Appeals on June 5, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Christopher Emmons with the Court of Appeals on June 4, 2014. Counsel filed the reply to the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Derrick Tyrone Blake v. State of South Carolina with this Court on June 2, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Christopher Lee Johnson with the Court of Appeals on May 28, 2014.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
