Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his application for post-conviction relief. David Alexander, of the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense, who is currently representing petitioner in this matter, seeks appointment of outside counsel due to a conflict of interest arising from petitioner's allegation that LaNelle DuRant, also employed by the Division of Appellate Defense, was ineffective in her representation of petitioner on direct appeal.
