Dear Judge Few:

James Smith's letter of July 11th requesting that you issue an order "enjoining the newspapers, their agents, and affiliates from continuing to publish the sealed, private transcript..." that is said to be part of the record in the above-referenced appeal has been provided to me. As I suspect you are aware, Mr. Smith is asking you to impose a prior restraint on the publication of a newspaper notwithstanding that prior restraints are presumed unconstitutional under the First and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution. *Nebraska Press Assn. v. Stuart*, 427 U.S. 539 (1976). *New York Times Co. v. United States*, 403 U.S. 713 (1971).
