ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal with the caption shown above. The notice of appeal lists several lower court case numbers. The certificate of service indicates that the notice of appeal has been served on the Attorney General of South Carolina.


To the extent the notice of appeal indicates that appellant is appealing 1996-CP-40-02278, 2004-CP-40-01635, and 2006-CP-40-05170,¹ the notice of appeal is hereby dismissed as to those cases since appeals in those matters have already be resolved and the remittitur sent. *Akbar v. State*, Appellate Case No. 1999-13849; *Akbar v. State*, Appellate Case No. 2007-65565; *Akbar v. State*, Appellate Case No. 2007-62719.

The notice of appeal indicates that appellant is appealing in 2007-CP-40-03741. The title of that case is *Basil W. Akbar v. Ray A. Lord*. The appeal as to that case is hereby dismissed for appellant's failure to (1) provide a copy of the order(s) on appeal, (2) pay the \$100 filing fee required by required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iii), SCACR, and (3) provide a proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been served on opposing counsel in the case.

¹ The notice of appeal actually references 2006-CP-40-1570. Appellant has apparently transposed the last two numbers since the case ending in -1570 is *Palmetto Health Alliance v. Cherry*, a case which does not involve appellant.

The notice of appeal indicates that appellant is appealing in 2008-CP-40-04822. That case is entitled *Basil Akbar v. Stanley Freeman*. The appeal as to that case is hereby dismissed for appellant's failure to (1) pay the \$100 filing fee required by required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iii), SCACR, and (2) provide a proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been served on opposing counsel in the case.

The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221, SCACR.
