
Respondent submits the June 16, 2014, is sufficiently clear. Pursuant to its terms, Appellant may not include the struck documents in the Record on Appeal, or reference them in his amended initial brief. To the extent Appellant seeks permission to refer to the struck matter in his Statement of the Case, Rule 208(b)(C), SCACR, provides the Statement is "a concise history of the proceedings," and it "shall not contain contested matters." Thus, the Statement is a procedural history of the lower court proceedings at issue (the annual review proceeding), and should not include any contested matter. Appellant may prepare a separate Statement of Facts to include what he argued during the hearing in this matter, with specific citation to the hearing transcript and/or the Order dated February 20, 2014. See Rule 208(b)(D), SCACR
