




Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I am responding, although belatedly, to your letter dated June 4, 2014, after Mr. Wlodarczyk brought to my attention that a motion had not been filed as requested. I apologize. The documents identified in the Appellant's Brief are actually copies of unreported South Carolina cases which were attached to the Brief for the convenience of the Court. They should probably have been identified as "Unreported Cases," rather than Exhibits. The cases from the Administrative Law Court are available on their website and the South Carolina Bar's Casemaker website. The circuit court case is not reported and is, I believe, on appeal to your Court.

My understanding of Rule 208(b) was that it required permission to supplement the record with new facts, but that it does not require a motion to include unreported decisions. I have prepared a motion asking for permission to include these decisions as requested.
