

ORDER

Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from a letter of Judge Larry B. Hyman, Jr., dated April 7, 2014. Under Rule 243 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and S.C.Code Ann. § 17-27-100, only a final decision or judgment in a post-conviction relief action is subject to appellate review. Since the letter of Judge Hyman is not the final decision in any of these post-conviction relief cases, this letter is not appealable. Accordingly, the notice of appeal is dismissed without prejudice. *Lewis v. State*, 368 S.C. 630, 630 S.E.2d 464 (2006). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
