





AFFIDAVIT


Comes now your affiant, who affirms that he is more than eighteen (18) years of age, and qualified to make the affirmation. That I was employed by the Appellant and his family to represent Appellant in the trial of above mentioned cases in the Court of General Sessions for Aiken County. At no time was there any agreement between Attorney and Client for the Attorney to represent Appellant in any appeal, and no legal fees were ever collected to do so. 
Re: YOUR APPEAL IS URGENT!
