Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your document titled appendix volume 1, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter:

- The personal data identifiers and other sensitive information have not been redacted as required by the Supreme Court's Order dated April 15, 2014, which can be found at www.sccourts.org/courtOrders/HTMLFiles/2014-04-15-02.htm. While the last name of the victim has been removed the first name is still present, which does not comply with the order listed above. Also, the last names of all of the minor children involved can be found within the record along with the victim's address and the name of the school that the victim attends. Some examples of pages numbers are 291, 306, 307, and 309. However, these are just page numbers that were observed while the record was being reviewed for compliance and there may be more instances where redactions are needed.
- The title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the document should be titled record on appeal.

- The document does not list all the attorneys that were named on the initial respondents brief. Specifically, Daniel E. Johnson, Solicitor Fifth Circuit, should be added to the cover of the record on appeal.
