Dear Solicitor Rogers:

Please be advised that the Remittitur in the appeal of Mr. Inman's Dillon County convictions and sentences was issued on July 24, 2014 after denial of the State's Petition for Rehearing the same date. The decision in State v. Damien Inman, Opinion No. 274042, filed June 18, 2014 is now final. The decision of the Supreme Court reversed Inman's convictions from December 16, 2010 and sentences of Judge Russo and remanded the indictments for a new trial.

By copy of this letter, with a separate email this date, we are requesting the Department of Corrections, through the Legal Advisor's Office and your office to coordinate the expeditious transfer of Mr. Inman to the custody of Dillon County for treatment as a pretrial detainee on each of the indictments involved in the remittitur.
