Re: Angias v. State, Appellate C.No. 2014-001071

Dear Mrs. Chief Justice Toul,

I forgive the Court for the wrong its done me and I know the truth of happened. I have never wed to none of ya'll about any of this. I did ~~not~~ do those killings the way the State say I did that is all a lie. I did not murder any one. And I am unlawfully convicted of murder. There was never a plan to do any of that like the State says. and it is truly a shame I cannot even get a fair appeal. And you voted in all the cases that I seen about belated appeals and because of your voting others were allowed that fair chance. Had I would have known about PCR I would have filed one timely. I never even heard from

my appeal lawyer after it was denied I only got
a letter from the court saying it was a Final
Judgment and that my lawyer was no longer my
lawyer. I only was trying to cope mentally with
the knowledge of the Life sentence I had to
do that was a very heavy burden for me at that
time. I was in a locked down unit because of
the gangs at that time they were having riot after
riot. I am not a gang member. I gave my life
to God way before I came to South Carolina from
Georgia. I don't have tattoos I don't do drugs I
don't drink. I devote my self to the youth. I
encourage self betterment. I got stabbed in one
of the ribs in the back and was placed on the
Administrative Protective Custody 7 bloods ran in
the room me and two elder ppl were hiding
in and they beat me and one stabbed me before
they took what we had and left. I was stuck on
lock up until I got transferred to another prison.
I came here and was placed in another locked
down unit that was having gang riots. I was
placed in places where even if I did know about
PCH I would not have ever had a chance to do

anything at all.

I do have good grounds for regret and in truth all I have been asking for is to be sentenced to the rightful crime that I committed. I did not want to go to trial from the beginning. I did not murder any one.

I know I did wrong I have now confirmed my life to the betterment of the ~~people~~ people as a whole. really I wish they ~~had~~ would let me give my life to the army or something more constructive. I feel sometimes like I changed my life @ all these years in vain. What good is justice when it only is used to laugh at the ones who know the value of life? Does not ~~that~~ justice mean to conform to the law? Is not justice the abstract principles by which right and wrong are defined? What is right about leaving an individual who is under the understanding that ~~his~~ his conviction is Final, ~~to~~ when in fact it is not, to fully understand that it is not Final. What does Final mean? It means coming to an end. And at that time that is exactly what I believed it was, the end. How am I to know it keeps going and going? I had to deal with the mental break down ~~to~~ that flooded my emotions. I was fighting

Suicidal thoughts and all other ~~dean~~ demons that plagued me. My family abandoned me cause they could not take it emotionally. That made it even worse on me mentally. I lost all hope what else was I to think? Other than that I had to do a life sentence with no chance of release for something I know I did not do. I did not plan to murder no one. I just lost control of my self. I was brought up as a child the wrong way. I did not know any better. I was a lost soul a lost cause. But God found me and he set me down and taught me better.

And the whole time I wrote this letter I cried swear to God Himself, because it hurts to know now that I don't get bar proceedings whether it was my fault ~~or~~ for not know due to my lack of understanding at the time or because the one person that is suppose to look out for my ~~the~~ best interest ~~do~~ does not do so.

And I just want the Court to know that that my God is all loving and all forgiving and because of that I forgive each and every one you that is responsible for denying me a bar chance at proving my innocence of murder and even though I was

not shown the mercy that others in my @ situation received I still pray that the Father above shows you mercy for the wrong committed against me.

The very book we all swear our oaths upon is the very book that states God's word says that we ~~shall~~ shall not bear false witness. And that is ~~the~~ exactly what happened to me they say I planned to go kill everyone like I am some devil. I never planned to kill those ~~people~~ people. I was afraid for my life and they did not do me any wrong. I told the police that but they didn't put none of that did they? The only thing that shows you I said that is ~~he~~ he did put where I stated it was not their fault, if it was not their fault then why did I plan to kill them? It don't make sense. Think about it Christ justice they are being on me and if I knew I could come and say that my lawyer was wrong I would have been done so. This just ain't right the way I am being treated I don't deserve bar proceedings? why? what did I do other than tell the truth when my lawyer and the state wanted me to lie. That's what I get for being honest and then the ones who lie to the court get a lesser punishment and we call

if justice. If justice does not care then who does? How can the people honestly say that Mrs is right? All I want is a fair shot to show the court the truth and if the people feel I did it shall then so be it I will thank God and more on like I did years ago when I thought it was over. But how can I honestly thank God now when I been robbed of the mercy and justice I been praying for the whole time my heart and appeal was on going.

And it hurts the most that I am now questioning my own father and creator ~~is~~ why he could be so cruel to me when He knows the truth.

Now I know why people say justice is only for the rich.

I was not able to send Mrs to Mrs Raligan at the attorney General's office but I did send her a letter like this one.

And I just want you'll to know that I forgive you.
