**RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO EXCEED THE PAGE LIMIT
PURSUANT TO RULE 243(g), SCACR**

1. The Respondent respectfully asks this Court to allow the Respondent's Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to exceed the twenty-five page limit outlined in Rule 243(g). Rule 243(g), SCACR (2014) states "The total length of a return shall not exceed twenty-five pages." 


